Dear Mr. Abraham:

The review of your application dated October 22, 2009, Company Code No. 102209, for the coated "Metal Lifeline" is complete.

This construction and the information provided meet the requirements of Part 18, Title 30 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), and the Standard Application Procedures for Acceptance of Flame-Resistant Solid Products Taken into Mines.

The following requirements apply to this acceptance:

1. Acceptance Marking No. "MSHA 18-LLA090002" must be permanently marked on the product with letters at least 1/4" high and at intervals not exceeding 3 feet. If the MSHA acceptance number cannot be marked on the product, it may be permanently and legibly marked with the assigned MSHA acceptance number on all shipping spools and/or containers.
 2. The construction is a 1/32" PVC coating over a 1/8" thick braided steel cable.
 3. You are obligated, as the manufacturer, to maintain the quality of the product to assure the requirements of this acceptance are being met.
 4. Any change in product composition or in any other factors that may affect this acceptance must not be made without prior authorization from MSHA.
 5. We have the right to revoke this acceptance for cause at any time.
 6. We must be notified of any transfer of production or ownership of this product.
